The Rev. Megan Jull was ordained in 2014 and has been the Incumbent of St. Augustine of Canterbury, in Leaside (Toronto) since 2018. Megan previously served at Church of the Redeemer as Associate Priest and was Curate at All Saints, Kingsway, in Toronto's west end. Prior to ordination, Megan served in a variety of lay ministry roles, including Pastoral Associate and Children and Youth Minister for several parishes in the Diocese of Toronto, and as a summer minister in rural parts of the Diocese of Quebec. She has been in active ministry for just over 20 years now.

Megan has always been passionate about children and youth and their inclusion in the life of the church. In June 2025, Megan began the Doctor of Ministry program at the Toronto School of Theology and is based at Trinity College. Her focus is playful liturgy and faith formation, from the lens of Universal Design for Learning. Megan has also begun working more broadly to equip children and youth ministers and was a workshop leader at this year's Toronto Children's Ministry Conference.

Chris is a high school teacher, teaching English and Computer Science in the private system at Crestwood Preparatory College.
